Reports may be made anonymously, but formal disciplinary action may not be based solely on an anonymous report. Any student who feels he/she is a victim of bullying/cyber-bullying/harassment should immediately contact a teacher, counselor, principal or staff person. Staff shall assist a student and/or parent/guardian in completing this complaint form, as requested.
