Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark Reading Assessments – These 1:1 comprehensive reading assessments help identify a range of books at each student's independent and instructional reading levels to support planning of differentiated reading instruction by teachers. Some assessments may take place during the school day, as it is difficult to assess all students within the time allotted after school:

- o Independent Reading Level = read, understand, and enjoy independently
- Instructional Reading Level = read, understand and enjoy with guidance, support and scaffolding by the teacher or an adult

Parent-Teacher Conferences – Teachers value meeting with parents to review the first semester progress report. Discussion topics include child's strengths and needs, learning styles, interests, and their progress toward meeting grade level standards. These conversations help us foster mutual respect, build a trusting partnership, and promote a personalized learning experience.
