Quality, Currency, and Availability of Textbooks and Instructional Materials

The Manhattan Beach Unified School District places a high value on the quality, condition, and availability of textbooks for all students. Textbooks and ancillary materials in core academic areas are selected with a strong focus toward alignment to state and District standards. New adoptions follow the recommendations of the District's instructional materials adoption committees, comprised of District teachers, administrators, parents, and students who spend hours reviewing, discussing, and evaluating all new materials. Textbooks are provided for all students in all grade levels in each of the core subject areas.

Manhattan Beach Unified School District recognizes that comprehensive library/multimedia centers are an integral part of the school culture. Over the past several years, with state and local monies, MBUSD has placed a high priority on purchasing library materials that enrich the classroom curriculum as well as provide a wide array of reference and recreational reading for students. Multimedia centers and computer labs are available at all sites and, at most sites, integrated into the library.
