Survey Content. The survey gathers information on behaviors such as physical activity and nutritional habits; drug use; school safety; and environmental and individual strengths and assets. The Healthy Kids Survey, along with more detailed information, is available to view at our <u>district's website</u> under the "Student Services Department" tab.

Administration. The survey will be administered in the winter. It will take about 30 minutes to complete and will be administered by one of your child's teachers.

Participation is Voluntary and Anonymous. Your child does not have to take the survey. No names or any other identifying information is connected to the answers except for the name of the school. Students who participate only have to answer the questions they want to answer, and they may stop taking the survey at any time.

Potential Risks. There are no known risks of physical harm to your child. Risks of psychological or social harm are very small. None have been reported in MBUSD during the 16+ years of survey administration. In rare instances, some questions might make students feel uncomfortable. As always, the school's staff and counseling services are available to answer any questions that may arise.
