Welcome to the MBUSD family! We want to help make the first steps in this process as easy as possible, and so we are providing the following step-by-step information about how to get started.

1. On or after March 2, 2020, complete the online enrollment form. This form can be found by going to the District's website at www.mbusd.org, clicking on the "[Enrollment](#)" link at the top of the page, and clicking on the "[New Student – Online Enrollment Portal](#)" link. Please be prepared to complete information regarding but not limited to, emergency contacts, allergies, etc. It is important that the information submitted be accurate and complete, as this data will be uploaded into our Student Information System and will become part of your child's permanent record.
2. Once you have completed the online enrollment form, please print 2 copies of the Verification Page, sign, and return one copy to your home school along with copies of all required documentation (listed on the next page). The MBMS office will be closed from June 25th to August 14th and re-open on August 17, 2020.
3. Watch for an email confirming your child's enrollment and informing you about additional forms and documentation that need to be completed before the first day of school. You can also view our calendar for important upcoming events and announcements.
4. New Student orientation will be on August 21 or 24, 2020 at 8:00 AM for our incoming 6th Grade Students! Please view the summer packet for details (available July) and check our website for more information.

If you are new to the Manhattan Beach area and your student(s) will be attending our schools for the first time, the following items are required in order to complete the registration process and will need to be brought in to the school office: *(Please bring one copy of each item).*

- New Student Enrollment Checklist
- Online Enrollment Verification Form (This will be printed after completing the online enrollment).
- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record Card
All students entering school are required to have proof of up-to-date immunizations, including chicken pox (varicella).
- Parent/Guardian's California Driver's License or ID Card
- Custody Documents (if applicable)
- Verification of Residence in Manhattan Beach
Verification of Residence in Manhattan Beach must be established before a child can be enrolled. Verification of Residence in Manhattan Beach requires the following:
 - Closed Escrow Papers, Grant or Deed, or Lease Agreement
 - A minimum of three (3) original current utility bills (NO PHONE BILLS) indicating service in the student's parent's name at his/her Manhattan Beach address.

New Residents: In addition to the above requirements, the school will need the original Closed Escrow Papers OR the Original Grant Deed OR the Original Lease Agreement. (New residents must supply utility bills within 30 days of move-in date).

If you have a lease agreement that includes utilities, you may substitute utility bills with a California Driver's License or ID Card, original bank statement, credit card or car insurance statements. If you have further questions, please call your school site. Manhattan Beach Unified School District does employ staff for the purpose of conducting on-site residency verification.

- Previous School Records/Grades
A copy of your student's most recent grades is requested to assist with scheduling. This is not a requirement as records will be requested directly from your student's previous school, however you may be contacted for more information if you do not provide this information.
- Completed Course of Study

Please complete the correct course of study for your students grade for the 2020-21 school year. Include any relevant information regarding your students desired schedule. Accelerated math and language may require testing (please view the Math Course Enrollment Prerequisites for more information).
